


What is OverDrive Read?

- <u>OverDrive Read</u> is a browser-based eBook reader that works on most computers, tablets, and mobile devices with up-to-date web browsers.
- With OverDrive Read, you can read borrowed eBooks right in your web browser without extra software or downloads.




How can I find something to borrow? You can browse books on the homepage, or select a category from the Collections, Subjects, or Levels menus.



How can I find something to borrow?

What do the icons on the covers mean? • The icon in the corner of each title tells you whether it's an eBook, audiobook, or video.




• Titles that are available to borrow have filled-in icons. If all copies of a title are checked out, the icon is grayed out.




How do I use the dictionary, notes, and highlights in OverDrive Read? In OverDrive Read, you can look up word definitions, highlight words or sections of an eBook, and add notes. To look up a **definition** or add a **highlight**, click (or tap) and hold a word, then select from the pop-up menu. When you add a highlight, you'll have the option to add a note.

Returning titles

- Your borrowed titles will automatically expire when they're due, which means you'll never be charged a late fee.
- You can also return titles right from your school's digital collection. Just select the Return Title button below the title on your <u>Checkouts</u> page (under your Account).






The **Renew** link becomes available three days before a title is set to expire and appears next to the title on your **Checkouts** page (under your **Account**). If the title already has holds, you can't renew it, but you can <u>request it again</u>.

On your **Checkouts** page, select the **Renew** link next to the title you'd like to renew.

If prompted, enter your date of birth.



How do I renew titles?

If you're over 13 years old:

Enter and confirm your email address, then click **Renew**. If you want the title to be automatically borrowed for you as soon as your current checkout expires (instead of being held for you on your **Holds** page), make sure that "Automatically borrow this title at the time of renewal" is selected.

How do I renew titles?

 As soon as the title is available, you'll receive an email with instructions to find the title on your Checkouts page (if you had it automatically borrowed for you) or to borrow the title again from your Holds page.




If you're under 13 years old:

A copy of the title will be placed on hold for you, so you can borrow it again as soon as it's available.

You can tell that you've successfully requested a title when you see a checkmark and the word Requested next to that title on

your Checkouts page.



 As soon as the title is available, you'll see a notification next to the Account icon on this website. This means that the title is available for you to borrow again from your Holds page.



How do I put an unavailable title on hold?

• If you're under 13 years old:

The title will be automatically placed on hold for you. When it becomes available for you to borrow, you'll see a notification next to the **Account** icon on this website.



 Once a hold becomes available, you'll only have 3 days to <u>borrow it</u>, so please check this site often to make sure you don't miss any notifications.

How do I borrow an available hold?

• Click or tap the **Account** icon.



• Select your Holds page.



• Select the **Borrow** button next to your available hold.

If you're over 13 years old, you can also <u>have your holds</u> <u>borrowed automatically for you</u> as soon as they become available.


