- Job search writing, subject-specific writing and materials for learners who take English as second language are also included.
- Writing process, mechanics, grammar and punctuation are also included.

[Europeana Collections](#) : Provides access to over 50 million digitised items – books, music, artworks with dedicated thematic collections on art, fashion, music, photography and World War I contain galleries. It has blogs and exhibitions to inform and inspire.

[Google Arts & Culture](#) : Provides collections from around the world with Google Arts & Culture created by Google Cultural Institute.

[The Met Collection](#) : Presents over 5,000 years of art from around the world from the Museum in New York City—The Met Fifth Avenue, The Met Breuer, and The Met Cloisters.
